

MAIN POINT:

God Cares For Me

BIBLE VERSE:

"Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord." Psalm 150:6

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

God's people were hungry in the wilderness. They didn't have any food. But God gave them special bread from heaven called manna!

DO IT → BASKETS OVERFLOWING

Supplies:

- Basket picture template (1 per child)
- Cotton balls (10 per child)
- Glue sticks
- Crayons

Activity Instructions:

- Have your preschooler colour the basket as desired.
- Help your preschooler put glue on the basket, and then place the cotton balls on the glue.

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TALK ABOUT IT:

1. **In our story today, God gave the people manna to eat when they were hungry. What does God give us to eat?** (Fruits and vegetables, noodles, chicken, yogurt - whatever your preschooler likes to eat!)
2. **When the people needed food, did God give them something to eat? (Yes!) Yes He did! Be on the lookout for ways that God cares for us every day. When you come across these things, point them out to your preschooler.** (We have fresh water for our bath, God cares for us. We have snuggly blankets for our beds, God cares for us. God sent rain, God cares for us.)

FAMILY PRAYER:

Dear Jesus, thank You for how You care for us. Thank You for all the things You give us. In Your name, Amen.

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
