

MAIN POINT:

God Is Mighty

BIBLE VERSE:

"Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord." Psalm 150:6

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

God asked Moses to help His people, the Israelites. Moses led the people out of Egypt, away from the bad king who had made them his slaves. When they got to the Red Sea, they couldn't cross and the king was coming to take them back! God told Moses to raise his staff, the water parted, and the people walked across on dry land. When they got to the other side, they praised God for what He had done.

DO IT → PRAISE HIM TAMBOURINES

Supplies:

- Small paper plates (2 per child) (styrofoam plates work too!)
- Dried beans (5 per child) (large beads work too)
- Paper streamers (3 – 1ft strips per child) (ribbons could also work)
- Crayons or markers
- Stapler

Activity Instructions:

- Let your preschooler decorate the backs of the plates with the crayons or markers.
- When they are done, have them place the five beans on one plate, and place the second plate, tops together, over top.
- Staple the plates together, adding the streamers or ribbon to the bottom of the tambourine as you close it.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- 1. God asked Moses to help His people, the Israelites. The Israelites were the slaves to a mean king but God saved them. When they were trying to get away from the mean king, they had to cross the Red Sea. When they got to the other side, they praised God for what He had done. What has God done for us that we can thank Him for? (He loves us and cares for us. He gives us family, food, friends, animals, etc.)**
- 2. Let's make a praise parade!** Line up your family members, follow the leader style, and shake your tambourines and worship God. Play some upbeat worship music, and take turns telling God how wonderful He is! (God you are good! You are mighty! We love you! We praise you. Thank you for _____.)
