- Assist different outside events hosted at CSC by setting up, operating, and tearing down AV for a variety of events such as but not limited to: Graduations, Spring Concerts, Funerals, etc.
- Provide administrative support by updating asset tracking as well as Tech on Site support for other events/ meetings at CSC throughout the Summer.

- Must be available to work the entire term of the employment with no time off in order to be in compliance with government grant funding requirements.
