CSCamps Coordinator

At our core, we are a network of small communities. These small communities function as extended families that support and challenge one another through discipleship. All of these communities networked together to make us united as one large church that gathers weekly for worship over services 9 across 5 campuses.

We are thrilled to announce that we are planning to hire several students this summer as part of our Student Leadership Development Program. *Hiring may be dependent on securing government grant funding.*

As a faith-based organization serving our community, we are seeking compassionate, motivated and service-oriented students to join our team and contribute to our mission. If you are a post-secondary or high school student with a heart for using your skills and abilities to make a difference in people's lives and are excited about how your experience can help us accomplish our mission of introducing people to Jesus and helping them become fully devoted followers of him, we would love to talk to you.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

This Summer Student would be invited to learn and grow in all aspect related to the successful execution of a CSCamps experience. This includes:

- Preparing and filming training videos for CSCamps Leaders.
- Develop and organize assigned creative projects that includes plans on how to complete the project, work with leaders, and continue to communicate effectively with CM Staff and leaders as the projects are completed.
- Leading a team of leaders in preparation for CSCamps. This includes organizing tasks, supplies and giving direction to build teams.



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- Work with a variety of building materials and supplies.
- Know all the different volunteer and staff roles and fill in as needed in the case of an absence.
- Ensure all administrative, organizational, and operational elements are thoroughly followed through, including all last minute requests.
- Work collaboratively with the Camp Operational Leadership Team (CScamps Director, Family Ministry Pastor, CScamps Administrator) to ensure everything leading up to, during, and after camp is attended to.
- Discovering and Deploying new volunteers (following CM onboarding process).
- Plan, develop and implement the different elements of the CScamps experience. This includes the creation of materials (i.e. props, PowerPoint, visuals) to be used for large group teaching/stations as well coordinating with CORE Logistics the materials, crafts, and activities that will be used by leaders for large and small group applications.
- Create and design the summer program environments (physical spaces) that are related to the Camp experience.
- In collaboration with the CM Core Team and other Summer Students, provide significant leadership in the promotion, administration, and running of CScamps. This includes:
 - Design, creation, building, and take down of CScamps Environments.
 - Effectively leading a group of leaders throughout the camp experience.
 - Preparation and implementation of the small group components.
 - Preparation and leading of interactive musical elements throughout the large group activities/group games.
 - Logistics, administration, and implementation of all field trips.

Core Skills/Experience:

- Summer students need to have the following skills/qualifications:
- Being comfortable and passionate about working directly with children and leaders who are investing in and discipling children during camp.
- Extroverted and capable / willingness to be in front of large groups of children and volunteers.
- Ability to lead their peers and those older than them.
- Previous work with children would be an asset.
- Think creatively and actively problem solve.
- Experience in discovering and developing volunteers.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Exceptional organizational and time/self-management skills.
- Possess a strong curiosity to learn and ask crucial questions.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to respectfully deal with conflict using the principles set out in Matthew 18.



- Flexible and adaptable.
- Ability and/or experience of working in a collaborative team environment.
- Ability to problem-solve/troubleshoot “on the fly.”
- Detail-oriented and has the ability to complete tasks quickly and effectively.

Qualifications:

- Understand, support and live out CSC’s membership covenant and statement of faith.
- Be a model to others of what it means to be a fully devoted follower of Christ.
- Willingness to commit to and uphold CSC’s Human Resources Policies, Code of Conduct, Confidentiality Agreement, Job Performance Expectations, Staff Values Based Behaviours, Lifestyle Agreement and Staff Expectations.
- Consider one of CSC campuses as your home church and have been attending for at least 6 months.
- Must be able to lift at least 50lb.
- Valid Class 5 driver’s license and access to a personal vehicle as travel to other locations (campuses, camp, etc.) is required.
- Must be available to work the entire term of the employment with no time off in order to be in compliance with government grant funding requirements.
