Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- **Well Café Host-** be available Monday and Wednesday nights to visit and help neighbours who access the Well Café. This role will offer support to volunteers, and plan additional events at the Well Café.
- **Kitchen Prep-** will assist the Chef with food prep for the Well Café. This position will be required to obtain their Food Handlers certificate.

- **ReNew Clothing-** work in collaboration with CFTC staff and volunteers to run a clothing drive, sort clothing, and build into the ReNew Clothing. This role will support neighbours who access the store by encouraging them and helping them to feel seen and supported while shopping for clothes.
- **Calgary Food Bank Support –** become familiar with the day-to-day responsibilities of the Centre Street Satellite depot and support as needed in packing and handing out hampers.
- **Additional Events-** Students will be plan and host events for the community at the Well Café based off community needs and interests.

Core Skills/Experience:

- Basic administrative background or knowledge required.
- A background in volunteerism would be an assist.
- Passionate about working with those experiencing poverty.
- Experience in discovering and developing volunteers.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Exceptional organizational and time/self-management skills.
- Possess a strong curiosity to learn and ask crucial questions.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to respectfully deal with conflict using the principles set out in Matthew 18.
- Flexible and adaptable.
- Ability and/or experience of working in a collaborative team environment.
- Ability to problem-solve/troubleshoot “on the fly.”
- Detail-oriented and has the ability to complete tasks quickly and effectively.

Qualifications:

- Understand, support and live out CSC’s membership covenant and statement of faith.
- Be a model to others of what it means to be a fully devoted follower of Christ.
- Willingness to commit to and uphold CSC’s Human Resources Policies, Code of Conduct, Confidentiality Agreement, Job Performance Expectations, Staff Values Based Behaviours, Lifestyle Agreement and Staff Expectations.
- Consider one of CSC campuses as your home church and have been attending for at least 6 months.
- Valid Class 5 driver’s license and access to a personal vehicle as travel to other locations (campuses, camp, etc.) is required.
- Must be available to work the entire term of the employment with no time off in order to be in compliance with government grant funding requirements.
