Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist in organizing and coordinating sports-related activities including sports camps, weekly sports activities, etc., ensuring alignment of the vision of Crossover Sports at Centre Street Church.
- Serve as the primary coach of an age appropriate basketball camp, coordinating skill-building sessions, drills, and friendly competitions for sport camp participants.
- Lead daily devotions, creating an environment that encourages spiritual growth and reflection among campers.
- Collaborate with Lead Pastor of Crossover Ministries to assist and execute a sports mission trip for high school students to North Battleford, Saskatchewan, incorporating both athletic and Christian service components.



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- Organize and supervise various athletic and recreational programs, ensuring a well-rounded and engaging camp experience.
- Foster teamwork, sportsmanship, and a positive camp culture among participants/ coaches/ parents/ other summer students.
