- Develop and implement a diverse range of sports and recreational activities aligned with the vision of Crossover Sports at Centre Street Church.
- Assist in the facilitation of daily sports camp activities, ensuring a balanced mix of sports, team-building, and faith-based activities.
- Foster a positive and inclusive environment, encouraging teamwork and sportsmanship among campers.



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- Plan and lead devotional sessions, integrating Christian teachings into the camp experience.
- Collaborate with fellow summer students and staff to organize special events, tournaments, and themed activities.
- Provide guidance and support to campers, promoting personal and spiritual growth.
- Ensure the safety and well-being of participants during all activities.
- Assist in the setup, maintenance, and teardown of activity areas.
