

T&T Parent Guide



T&T (Truth and Training) engages 3rd-6th graders by answering their questions about God and the Bible, guiding them through this pivotal life stage to grow in Christ's grace. Handbooks and large-group lessons deepen a child's knowledge about God and His Word and teach how to put that knowledge into action in everyday life. Each handbook has a fun and engaging Bible study for students to learn and engage in the grace of God. Each handbook contains 30 Bible Studies, memory verses, extra credit sections plus a fun story about T&T Super Agents.

The T&T Handbooks:

- Grace in Action
- Evidence of Grace
- Agents of Grace
- Discovery of Grace



In small group time, clubbers will work on **sections all together, one per week**, with discussion and will recite verses they have memorized. Sections in each T&T handbooks are grouped into a four units, where clubbers complete the Start Here, Explore, Memorize and Review portions of each section. All sections in the book must be completed in order so review sections will need to completed at the end of a unit. The clubbers can work towards an AWANA Go badge by completing two service items, which includes Bring-A-Friend. T&Ts earn awards for both section/unit completions as well as the end of handbook year end awards. If your clubber finishes their handbook early there are extra credit sections in each handbook that can be completed which are the Silver and Gold sections.

Each club night begins at 6:30pm and ends at 8:00pm. AWANA T&Ts rotate through a variety of activities, which include Games/Crafts, Large Group Lesson Time, and Small Group/Handbook time. Please have your clubber bring their uniform, Bible, handbook and running shoes for games time each week.

We strongly encourage you to work with your child in their AWANA handbook! Help them memorize the Bible verses and talk with them about what that verse means and how they can use it in their life. Read the Bible passages and answer the questions as a family. The handbooks have tools (online resources) and practical suggestions to help you as you learn and study together. Just a few minutes a day can yield eternal rewards!
